

WALMART paying to JAIL and SILENCE sweatshop workers?!

Garment workers and worker rights advocates in Bangladesh were **seized in a witch hunt, thrown in jail, and tortured**- all for protesting against the sweatshop conditions of the **lowest paid workers** in the world.

The culprits guilty of filing the unfounded criminal charges to silence workers and advocates are the Nassa Group and Envoy Group –two of Walmart's major suppliers in Bangladesh.



Tell the store manager that Walmart must **stop funding sweatshop abuse** and repression by suspending all orders to Nassa and Envoy until the criminal charges are dropped and freedom of speech is respected.
